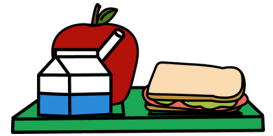

Dear Parents,

As we prepare for this wonderful season, we would like to invite you and your family to our Christmas program, *The Next Noel*. This is a sequel to our last year's performance, *The First Leon*. We will have 2 performances. The first one will be at 10:00 AM on Thursday, December 14. The other one will be that evening at 6 PM. We know the evening will be much more crowded, so if you can attend the morning performance, we would suggest that you try to make it to that one.

Our students have been working very hard on getting this performance together. The Tuesday and Thursday classes for the 2, 3, and 4 year old students will be in the program, along with the other students from grades K-8th. All Mother's Day Out, preschool, and kindergarten students will meet in their classrooms for the evening performance. They may begin arriving at 5:30. After the students perform, parents will be asked to come to the front and get their children for the rest of the performance.
